NED & NADINE

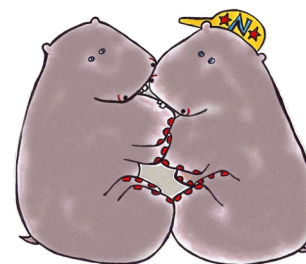
I've got a brother named Ned

We're Ned and Nadine



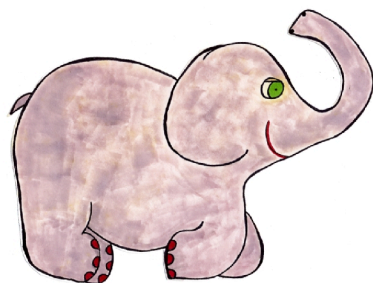
How could we look so alike
